## Module 3: Sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV)

Activity 2: A case study (75 minutes)

#### **Materials**

Flipchart paper and pen or projector

#### **Preparation**

For this session you will need to find a faith leader in your community that has successfully dealt with SGBV issues. The presenters should talk to different types or aspects of SGBV and the challenges they faced and how they overcame them.

It is important that you brief the presenter on what you would like them to do well in advance of the actual session. They will have no more than 45 minutes and will then be taking questions.

### **Objectives**

An external presenter will discuss SGBV, with a particular focus on the role of faith leaders and institutions in combatting all forms of SGBV. The presenter will highlight the challenges and successes.

#### **Steps**

- 1. Introduce the presenter to the participants.
- 2. Let her/him get started, and give them 45 minutes to present.
- 3. After the presentation is finished open the floor for questions. If participants have trouble thinking of questions, you can get them started by asking questions like:
- a) What was the greatest challenge you faced in your work?
- b) How did you overcome that challenge?
- c) Has the change you've created been lasting? How do we ensure that the gains we make in SGBV prevention are effective in the long term?
- 4. After about 30 minutes, thank the expert for their time and ask if participants have any final thoughts or comments.
